

**POWER OF ATTORNEY TO
DELEGATE PARENTAL AUTHORITY
PURSUANT TO CRS § 15-14-105**

A parent or guardian of a minor or incapacitated person, by a power of attorney, may delegate to another person, for a period not exceeding twelve months, any power regarding care, custody, or property of the minor or ward, except the power to consent to marriage or adoption. IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS ABOUT THESE POWERS, OBTAIN LEGAL ADVICE.

This Power of Attorney shall become effective immediately and shall not be affected by my disability or lack of mental competence, except as may be provided otherwise by an applicable state statute. This Power of Attorney shall continue for a period of twelve (12) months from the date hereof, unless sooner revoked by me in writing. This Power of Attorney may be revoked by me at any time by providing written notice to my Agent.
