The ski season is coming up and people are getting ready for the year. Telluride locals are looking to buy ski passes hoping for a good winter, especially after last year's debacle. Ski Resort early bird season pass sale is underway. The sooner you come in and grab a pass the cheaper it will be.

Purchasing a season pass before or during the ski swap and

it will cost less: \$1,200 for an adult pass, \$375 for kids ages 6-12, \$400 for young people between ages 13-18, \$449 for young adults between the ages 19-24 and \$749 for seniors between ages 65-79.
